### **RECOGNIZING AN AMERICAN HERO IN THE PENNSYLVANIA SENATE**

> As Chairman of the Senate Law and Justice Committee, I was actively involved in the confirmation process for Pennsylvania State Police Commissioner Christopher Paris. Colonel Paris appeared before the committee, which voted to advance his nomination. He was later confirmed by the full state Senate. Paris has served with the Pennsylvania State Police since he began his careter as a 22-year-old cadet.
